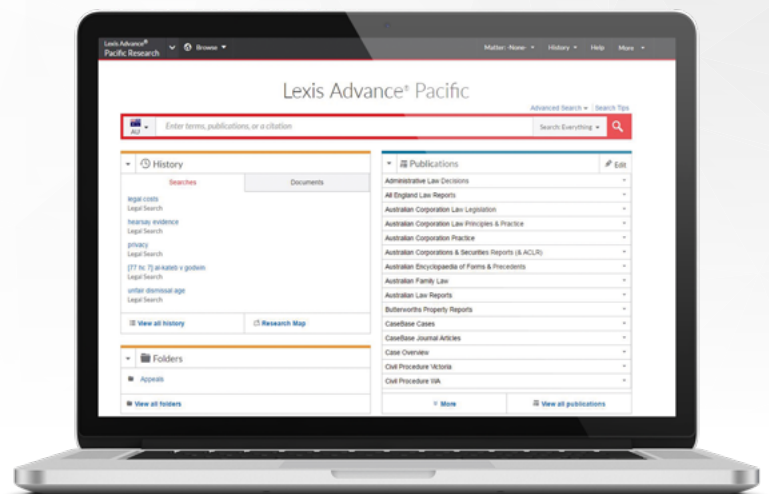

How to apply

Eligible barristers must complete and submit the Expression of Interest form by 29 June 2018 to the Bar Association of Queensland at: Ground Floor Inns of Court, 107 North Quay, Brisbane Qld 4000.

This offer is contingent on the following:

- 300 individual barristers returning their Expression of Interest (EOI) form to the Bar Association of Queensland by 4 July 2018.
- By 13 July 2018, LexisNexis will confirm whether the offer will proceed to the issuing of contracts.
- All contracts must be executed and received by LexisNexis on or before 17 August 2018.
- If the offer proceeds, LexisNexis will issue contracts for *The Queenslander Power Pack* to those barristers who have registered their interest via the process outlined above.

Special Considerations offered for Judicial Appointments and Retirements

- If a Barrister subscribes to *The Queenslander Power Pack* then subsequently accepts a Judicial Appointment during the term of the contract, the contract may be terminated by the Barrister on 30 days' notice, and an adjustment made on a pro rata basis.
- If a Barrister subscribes to *The Queenslander Power Pack* then subsequently retires from practice (no longer holding a practicing certificate) during the term of the contract, the contract may be terminated by the Barrister on 30 days' notice, effective from the next renewal anniversary date.
